Staying Put

When a young person turns 18, they can either move onto independence or remain in placement under a staying put arrangement. If you would like to consider this with one of your yp please speak to your SSW when your yp turns 17 and a half. It is very important this is planned with management authorisation. Carers are paid for staying put however payment varies between local authorities and decreases as they get older.
