Placements Updates

Currently we are getting a mixture self-isolate for 14 days if: of placements coming in, there is a . high need for parent and child placements and sibling groups up . to three and four young people. Please remember siblings can only share a room if they are young and the same gender. Currently we are not getting many UASC coming through due to the weather, which is normal for the time of the year.

Many local authority social workers are still working from home and therefore trying to maintain placements instead of moving young people. They are still moving challenging placements due to placement breakdowns. We are hoping in the new year some more standard placements will be coming available.

With London being placed in Tier 3, We would like to welcome Senior our office will be closed from Practitioner, Deborah and SSWs Wednesday 16th December 2020 until the tier is lowered. Calls to the office will still be answered should you need to contact the team.

> You will usually need to self-isolate for at least 10 days. You'll usually need to

- someone you live with has symptoms or tested positive
- someone in your support bubble has symptoms or tested positive
- you've been told to self-isolate by **NHS Test and Trace**

DBS & Health & Safety

The following people must have a DBS if at a fostering household

- Household members
- Regular visitors
- Back up carers
- Support network
- Staying put young people

Having a valid DBS for anyone who is around a young person is extremely important, which is why we are constantly chasing this up with carers. DBS applications must be completed 3 months prior to your existing one expiring. Please email Bayley if you have any questions.

Training

We will be holding virtual training until further notice. The Training Schedule for 2021 has been issued – please discuss this with your SSW.

You are required to complete a minimum of 5 (8 for new carers) trainings per year.

New Foster Carers must complete Safeguarding training within their first 12 months.

Paediatric First Aid Training Certificates are valid for 3 years. Please contact your SSW or Louise if your certificate has expired.

Coronavirus Training is compulsory – this must be completed by 31st December 2020.
